

Special-Status Bat Species License Article

Prior to conducting any non-routine maintenance activities that result in harm to special-status bat species or their habitat, in structures that are known to support maternal or roosting bat species (including but not limited to, reconstruction and painting) (Table 1), the Licensee shall consult with California Department of Fish and Game (CDFG), FS, and USFWS. Based on the consultation, the Licensee shall implement appropriate avoidance and protection measures if necessary to minimize disturbance of special-status bat species or their habitat.
